**1. By Cheque**

**2. By Credit Card**

**3. By E-Transfer**

For those wishing to pay by e-transfer you may do so by sending the transfer to the RTFFA via email [mail@retiredtorontofirefighters.org](mailto:mail@retiredtorontofirefighters.org). You can email security question/answer to the above as well.

- a) E-transfers – as we have members with the same or similar names, please be sure that we can properly identify who the payment is from. Most e-transfers provide for a

**message to be added**, please use this feature to inform us of whom you are and that the funds are for your membership dues.

Because we all must work to keep each other healthy and safe we ask that you do not go to the Association office to pay by cash; the Association office is CLOSED and will not allow outside entry until further notice.
